SAN DIEGO ZOO***INITIAL INVESTIGATION

A. Coeration

The Zoc is located on City-cumed property. It is managed by the Zoclogical Seciety of San Diego, a California non-profit corporation. The Zoc was taken over by the Society in 1922, with the sanction of the City Parks and Recreation Department. Ordinance #1845 new series grants the Zoclogical Society"the right to occupy, maintain the operate zoclogical gardens in Balbos Park, Committing in said Society custody and maintenance of Zoclogical exhibits therein. The most recent new series "Ordinance #6605 was adopted by the Council of the City of San Diego on August 2, 1955, enabled by section 77s of the Charter of the City of San Diego as amended. According to City Charter amendment 24 per \$100 accessed *valuations* all property is given the Society for the support of the Zoc. The amount in the proposed budget for 64165 \$200.425. (Some previous allotments:1960-61, \$172,312; 1961-62, \$133,556; 1962-63, \$188,466; 1963-64, \$192,972;]

The governing body of the Society is a Board of twelve trustees.

The governing body of the Society is a Board of twelve trustees. They appoint a Director who employs the operating staff. The Society operates on a fiscal year, July 1 to June 30. Its annual meeting is held on the first Wednesday following Labor Day. The Board meets monthly

throughour the year and makes policy decisions.

There are approximately 15 Negro employees. Nost are working in the low-pay, clean-up type jobs. All Negro woman(3 regular and 3 part-time) are Custodians of restrooms. (There are also 3 White men custodians who clean the men's restrooms)

Nost Negro men are Groundsmen (cleaning grounds). A few are doing ga gardening-type work. There is one butcher's helper and one delivery men. Only one male Negro was hired for seasonal work this summer.
