Dear Mr. Brown:

Your statement, "---to discuss some facts which have been brought to our attention concerning the exclusion of Negroes in practically all of your job categories except that defined as custodian and groundsmen, and the working conditions under which the Negro custodians work" has no basis in fact. As stated in my letter to you there is not now, nor has there been, a practice of discrimination concerning job opportunity or working conditions in the Zoological Garden. There is no practice of exclusion in any form. It should be pointed out, also, that recently a disinterested federal government body has investigated our employment practices and found them to be entirely satisfactory.

There are well formulated procedures for handling grievances and there have been none in these areas. Open jobs in the zoo are posted on bulletin boards and our personnel director is always hopeful that promotions can be made from within. Regardless of the position, anyone in the zoo can aspire to, and be promoted to, a better position if he can satisfy the job requirements.

We will appreciate a letter if you have specific information which indicates the zoo is discriminatory in hiring or in working conditions.
