

Suggested Revisions To
New Core Constitution

Membership: Article III

A. New Members: - Requirements

- 1. Perspective members must be sponsored by a member of the local core chapter.
- 2. Perspective members must attend two consecutive meetings.
- 3. Candidate must attend one orientation meeting and must pass an interview conducted by a board of core members.
- 4. Candidate will be voted on for probationary membership at third meeting.
- 5. The candidate shall be a probationary member for three months.
- 6. Candidate must pay the required membership fee of \$3.00.

B. Probationary Period - Three months.

During this period of probation the member must demonstrate his acceptance of all of Core's "Rules for Action" by:

- 1. Participating actively on at least one standing committee of his choice.
- 2. Participating in any direct action project through
 - A. Investigation
 - B. Negotiations
 - C. Picketing
 - D. Sit-Ins, Lay in or chair/Ins.
 - E. Civil disobedience if necessary;
 - F. Participatin in any other direct action the chapter may deem as necessary.
- 3. At the end of the three month probationary period the Executive Committee of successful termination of said period by member and shall be assigned to active; associate or sustaining membership

C. Membership shall consist of Active, Associate and sustaining members.

1. Active Members shall result when:

- A. Successful completion of probationary period has been fulfilled
- B. Participation in points "I" and "Z" of Section B "Probationary Period".
- C. Agree to abide by Core Rule for Action and the Constitution of the National and local chapter of core.
- D. Agree the members does not advocate the overthrow of the federal, state or local government.

2. Associate Members:

- A. Pay membership fee of \$3.00 per year.
- B. Attend two consecutive meetings.
- C. Agree to abide by the national and local constitution and Corolla "Rules for Action"
- D. This member would not vote.

3. Sustaining Membership

- A. Minimum contribution of \$10.00
- B. This member would not vote.

4. Transferrance of Members:

- A. members may transfer from other local chapters upon written recommendations of said chapter and agreement to abide by local core constitution and core rules for action.
- B. By regular procedure followed by all perspective members.

Budget Committee

- 1. The budget committee shall consist of three members elected annually in addition to the Treasury of the local chapter.
- 2. The Budget Committee shall receive requests from each standing committee and office manager on need expenditures on a quarterly basis this shall be made by a requisition at the end of each preceding Quarter.
- 3. Requisitions will be made for emergency funds not to exceed \$25.00 by approval of the majority members of the Executive Board.
- 4. The Budget Committee shall perform a audit on a Quarterly basis at the first meeting of the Quarter and shall
 - A. Audit all financial records and report to Budget.
 - B. Make a quarterly report to the general membership
 - C. All expenditures shall be accounted for by receipts.
