We, the undersigned, respectfully petition to be allowed to serve one day each of the jail sentence imposed on civil rights leader Harold K. Brown. It is our conviction that any legal offense for which he was convicted was committed for the good of humanity and in the spirit of a law that transcends man's local, prevailing statutes. If he is guilty and deserves punishment, we gladly partake of that guilt and sincerely ask to share in that punishment.

Such a petition was granted by Superior Court Judge Vincent Whelan to allow Dr. Charles C. Collins to serve the sentence imposed on Mrs. Anna M. Collins. With this precedent in mind, we request that you take whatever legal action is necessary to assign each of us to serve one day in jail in lieu of Harold K. Brown, recognizing that at least one day of the 15 day sentence will be served by Mr. Brown.
